III. Live a Life of No Wasted Effort!

<u>Every</u> effort I expend to advance the purposes of God in this world, no matter how big or how small, how visible or how hidden, is never in vain.

Hebrews 13:5 (NIV)

Because in Christ nothing is wasted, NOTHING we do in the Lord is in vain.
