I. Most of Us Look Back on Our Lives and Realize That as We Get Older We Tend to Get Wiser...but Not Always! *Proverbs* 27:22

II. How Do We Actually Learn Anything?

- A. The hard way: through personal experience.
 - 1. This is the school of hard knocks.
 - 2. Two huge drawbacks:
 - a. No guarantee of learning anything.
 - b. A promise of great pain...
- B. The easy way: through the experiences of others.
- III. Thinking Wisely.
- A. Knowledge is the accumulation and assimilation of information.
- B. Wisdom is the appropriate and timely application of knowledge.
- C. A key but elusive concept: cause and effect.
 - 1. None of us wants to forfeit our right to choose, but we are quick to <u>abdicate</u> our responsibility for the outcome that results from our actions. *Proverbs 6:27-29*
 - 2. You get what you got when you do what you did!
- IV. How to Make Wise Decisions.
- A. Ask God for wisdom. Proverbs 9:10; James 1:5; Proverbs 1:20-23
- B. Read my Bible every day. Psalm 119:97-99; Proverbs 1:1-4, 7
- C. Let a few people into my heart deeply. Proverbs 4:23; Jeremiah 17:9
- D. Use multiple <u>counselors</u> in my decision making. *Proverbs 11:14 (Message); Proverbs 15:22*
- E. Keep a record of my life lessons. Proverbs 24:32; 2 Timothy 2:7
