In these stories, extraordinary efforts are made because lost people matter to Jesus, and if they matter to Him, they should matter to us!

When a lost person is found, they receive eternal life.

This weekend our church is embarking on a season of great effort and sacrifice, to seek and find the people who are such a treasure to God, called the ONE Campaign.

Luke 15:10

11:00 is what we call our Optimum Inviting Hour, when a service is 80% full...it's full!

The ONE is a two year spiritual campaign in which we need every Savannah Christian to make a commitment to give sacrificially above your regular tithes and offerings.

"Lord, what do you want me to sacrifice so we can seek and save the one You and I love who is lost?"

On Monday, March 10th, we are starting 21 days of prayer and fasting. Monday through Saturday for the next 21 days we're going to have a special prayer service at 7:00am at all of our campuses.

Fasting is giving up something you love, to intensify your prayers, for something you love more.

Someone precious to God is lost...and any sacrifice we make to lead them home will be worth it a hundred times over!

ONE Prayer

This first week of the ONE Campaign, we want to focus on the greatness of our God. In any relationship, we first want to *know about* the person, but then, as we form a deeper relationship, we want to *know* the person. God knows us because He created us:

"For You formed my inward parts; You knitted me together in my mother's womb." Psalm 139:13

This week during your prayer time, focus on not only what you know about God (His goodness, His power, His love) but also on who He is to you (My Provider, The Lover of my soul, My Protector, My Good Shepherd, My Savior.....). Ask Him to speak to you about who He wants to be in your life.
