I. Why Some People <u>Don't</u> Grow Spiritually Strong.

- 1. Some people have hearts that are <u>hard</u> toward the truth. Zechariah 7:11-12
- Hardened by their <u>upbringing</u>.
- Repetitive <u>sin</u> can harden people's hearts. *Hebrews 3:13*
- <u>Pride and arrogance can harden people's hearts.</u>

Daniel 5:20

- Some hearts are hardened by <u>painful</u> circumstances.
- Some are hardened by <u>hypocrisy</u> they see in Christians.
- Some are hardened because of <u>familiarity</u>.

Jesus Christ loves people with hard hearts. Hebrews 3:7-8

2. Some people have <u>shallow</u> hearts.

John 6:66, 68-69

Here's the good news...shallow people can grow <u>deep</u>! The great thing about this soil and our hearts: they can <u>change</u>! God uses three things to make shallow hearts deep:

- Knowledge of the <u>Bible</u>.
- <u>Christian</u> relationships.

Life-change and spiritual growth both happen best in small groups!

- Compassionate <u>service</u>.
- 3. Some people have <u>distracted</u> hearts.
