Spiritual Growth always begins on the inside and works its way out.

We can't fix the fruit without changing our roots.

Key Question: What is the purpose of the soils?

Two Implications about this parable:

- Every one of us <u>fits</u> in this parable somewhere
- Soil can <u>change</u>!

How do we prepare the soil for growth?

The process of seeing real change come from the inside out consists of two words: training and trusting.

<u>Training</u>

• When you focus on the roots the fruit will <u>follow</u>.

"Train yourself for godliness." 1Timothy 4:7

"His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence." 2 Peter 1:3

"For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they keep you from being ineffective or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ." 2 Peter 1:5-8

<u>Trusting</u>

• You need to be <u>faithful</u> in training and you can trust Him to bring the <u>fruit</u>.
