#### I. Honor Your Mother with Obedience When You're Young. Luke 2:46-52

If you're rebellious, your heart can be like rock hard soil toward your mom. Ephesians 6:1-3

As a student you have a call on your life from God and that includes obeying your parents.

### II. Honor Your Mom with Respect When You're a Young Adult. John 2:1-5

"'Woman' is not as cold in the Greek as it is in English." Leon Morris

Don't let your heart be like that shallow soil, where the first time your Mom disappoints, you let your love wither.

#### III. Honor Your Mom by Being Patient When She is Wrong. Mark 3:20-21, 31-35

"The four people you have the most difficulty forgiving are your mother, your father, yourself and God." Bob Russell

Sometimes we may be tempted to be like that thorny soil in the parable and let our ego or insecurity or <u>arrogance</u> choke our love for our Mom.

#### IV. Honor Your Mom by Providing for Her When She is in Need. John 19:25 -27

Like that good seed falling on good soil in the parable...Jesus and His mom's relationship grew and grew through every season of life.

Jesus honored His mom because, if nothing else, she brought Him into the world and gave Him the <u>opportunity</u> to honor God with His life.
