I. Compassionate People Give Gifts!

Psalm 15:4 NLT

How to become a compassionate person:

- 1. Keep your word.
- 2. Learn to love unconditionally.

Unconditional love just looks for an opportunity to express itself.

Grace is giving something to someone who doesn't earn it and can't repay it.

II. Compassionate People Take Risks.

2 Samuel 16:3, 2 Samuel 19:25-28, 2 Samuel 19:30

David had to take the risk of facing some complexity, because he was so compassionate.

"Kindness is the language the deaf can hear and the blind can read." Mark Twain

III. Compassionate People Take Action.

Practical lessons on expressing compassion:

Compassion is more than just words or feelings.

Compassion isn't just making a promise or feeling sorry for somebody. It's expressing <u>deeds</u> of mercy and kindness. James 2:15-17

2. Compassion is more than reacting – it seeks out needs.

Compassion does more than just respond to obvious needs; it looks for opportunities.

Compassion is looking for needs that others overlook. 2 Peter 1:5-9

3. Compassion is more than giving money; it is building <u>relationships</u>.

Psalm 112:4 NLT, John 13:35
