A disciple in it's simplest definition is a "follower."

The Jewish Pharisees were considered legalist because they had reduced their faith to a rigid set of rules and regulations.

The Bible says the angels in Heaven celebrate when someone comes to Christ... why wouldn't we?
Ecclesiastes 3:4

II. Pursue Change Even When the Unconvinced Complain.

The new wine was poured into new wineskins because they were flexible.
