Crucifixion was done to thousands, but only chosen by one.

"No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of My own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again." John 10:18

You are released from all guilt, shame, and any sense of worthlessness, because Jesus bore all those upon Himself on the cross. Justice was <u>completed</u> on the cross; it does not remain for those in Jesus anymore.

Beholding the Crucifixion Speaks to Us:

- 1. It reminds us not to take lightly anymore any sin in our lives, because Jesus has to <u>suffer</u> for some things in our lives that we take lightly.
- 2. It reminds us of the honor and glory that is continually <u>due</u> to Jesus Christ.
- 3. It reminds us that sins are paid for: it is <u>done</u>. If you have put your faith in Jesus, it is done. You cannot do more than what Jesus paid to <u>add</u> to your forgiveness.
