The command that is repeated in the Bible the most is: "Do not be afraid!"

Facing fear is universal.

Healthy faith in God is stronger than any fear that attacks our heart and mind. Psalm 46:3

#### Two Questions about Fear:

1. When I'm afraid, where is my focus?

You can either focus on your faith or on your circumstances...but not both.

When you feel afraid, you need to learn to focus on <u>Jesus</u> rather than the thing that scares you! *Luke 12:7* 

The problem is that when we're in trouble we are tempted to focus on the storm outside the boat instead of the Lord inside the boat!

"Even though you walk through the valley of death you will fear no evil, because I am with you." Psalm 23:4

2. When I'm afraid, where is my confidence?

When Jesus is in your boat, you don't have to be afraid, even when you have reason to be afraid.

"I will never leave you or forsake you.' So we can confidently say, 'The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?" Hebrews 13:5-6

"You rule the raging of the sea; when it's waves rise, you still them." Psalm 89:9

Isaiah 26:3
