JESUS: GOD REVEALED

Jesus Makes the Impossible...Do-able!, Luke 9:10-17 June 10,13-14, 2015: Cam Huxford, Senior Pastor

Hebrews 1:1-3

This story is so important that it's the <u>only</u> miracle recorded in all four Gospels: *Matthew 14:13-21; Mark 6:30-44; Luke 9:10-17 & John 6:1-15.*

I. Learn From Phillip: Don't Measure Your Problems by Your Own Strength! John 6:5-6

There are times when Jesus will ask us to deal with seemingly impossible things to test us!

Philip said: This is impossible because it will cost too much!

Jesus Loves to Put Us in Impossible Situations:

- 1. Jesus puts us in impossible situations to stretch our undeveloped faith.
- 2. Jesus puts us in impossible situations to strengthen our eternal hope.
- 3. Jesus puts us in impossible circumstances to show us His incredible love.

II. Learn From Andrew: Little in the Hands of Jesus Becomes Much! John 6:8-9

Andrew said: This is impossible because we have too little!

How Jesus Tests Us to Make Our Faith Strong:

- 1. He <u>reduces</u> our resources.
- 2. He <u>magnifies</u> our need.
- 3. Then someone trusts God with what little they have.
- 4. God <u>uses</u> the little we have to show how great He is.

III. Learn From Jesus: Every Encounter with the Impossible Can Bring an Increase!

Two Questions We Need to Answer Today:

- 1. Like Phillip: What have I decided in my life is too big for God to handle?
- 2. Like Andrew: What have I decided in myself is too little for God to work with?

An impossible problem + an Omnipotent God = a certain increase!
