Getting connected to Christ and other Christ followers is what the Bible calls fellowship.

"They devoted themselves to the Apostle's teaching, and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers." Acts 2:42

Fellowship comes from the Greek word koinonia which means "to share life."

I. Fellowship Makes Me Spiritually Solid, like a Brick in a Strong Building!

"You are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a Holy Temple in the Lord. In Him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God." Ephesians 2:19-22

II. Fellowship Positions Me as a Vital Part of a Healthy Body.

"Just as our bodies have many parts and each part has a special function, so it is with Christ's body. We are many parts of one body, and we all belong to each other." Romans 12:4-5 NLT
