Matthew 6:19-21

I. A Problem to Solve.

Problem #1: The rich man ignored the needs in his world. *1 Timothy 6:17-19*

The point is not just to feel good, but to do good! *Proverbs 22:9*

Problem # 2: The rich man ignored the reality of his own mortality.

A prior decision, not desire, will dictate your direction at death. *Hebrews 9:27 KJV*

II. A Punishment to Endure.

When death comes, it is not good news for everybody.

Jesus talked more about Hell than He did about Heaven!

III. A Prescription to Fill!

The prescription for avoiding a big problem and a severe punishment:

1. Honor God while you can!
