"Gifts that Change Everything", Luke 18:9-14 December 9, 12-13, 2015: Cam Huxford, Senior Pastor

A parable is a little story with a big message that is usually trying to make a single main point.

### I. Give the Gift of <u>Authenticity</u>.

### What Jesus teaches us about the Pharisee:

- 1. Reject a false sense of security. Isaiah 64:6 NIV, Titus 3:5
- 2. Avoid arrogant attempts to <u>impress</u>.
- 3. Refuse foolish <u>comparisons</u> with others.

### Four types of pride that causes us to compare ourselves with others:

- Race pride Galatians 3:28
- <u>Face</u> pride
- Place pride
- Grace pride Romans 3:10,23-24

Jesus came to the manger, so He could go to the cross in our place!

If we give into this kind of pride and self promotion...it won't impress God...but it will influence people...negatively!

### II. Give the Gift of <u>Humility</u>.

<u>Justification</u> occurs when Jesus takes the punishment for our sin on the cross...and gives us a righteousness that is not earned, but comes as a gift when we seek a relationship with Him. In Christ, God then sees us "just as if we'd never sinned", because of His grace.

### How Jesus describes the Tax Collector:

- 1. His motives are sincere.
- 2. His evaluation is honest.
- 3. His repentance is genuine.

### III. Give the Gift of <u>Generosity</u>:

- 1. Compare yourself more with <u>Jesus</u> and less with others.
- 2. Reach out in friendship to the person with whom you disagree.
- 3. Listen patiently to those who are <u>different</u> than you.
- 4. Practice seeing people the way <u>God</u> sees them.
