Financial peace is a by-product of generous decisions you make and values you live out.

The generous decisions that lead to financial peace are the opposite of what will come naturally for any of us.

Living out the values that lead to financial peace often begins with a life-changing relationship with Jesus.

Zacchaeus was really smart with money, because his generosity was driven by a plan that involved percentages.

In the Old Testament, the standard for giving was the tithe: 10% of your gross earnings. Then in the New Testament, Jesus affirmed the tithe and called tithers to be generous!

"Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine." Proverbs 3:9

10/10/80 plan: 10% is your tithe.

10% is your savings. 80% is what you live on.
