Ever since Satan tempted Adam and Eve to question God's character in the Garden of Eden...we've all struggled with authority. Exodus 20:7

When we become a follower of Jesus we make a deliberate decision to submit our wills to the authority of God.

Romans 6:12-14 NLT; Romans 7:18-19

I. Round #1: The Chief Priests Question Jesus about His Personal Authority.

John the Baptist was a prophet of God, and he had clearly identified Jesus as the Messiah.

The Jesus of the Bible is not on trial. His authority has been proven by His <u>resurrection</u> and His lordship over the church of 2,000 years.

II. Round #2: The Pharisees Question Jesus about Political Authority.

If Jesus is Lord, He's Lord over you and your political involvement as a citizen of your country. Proverbs 8:15 NIV

Pray about three things as we work our way through this political season:

- Make plans to participate.
- · Put people first!

Any variance from Biblical values is bad for people.

Pray for noble leaders.

III. Round #3: The Sadducees Question Jesus about Eternity.

Jesus makes two things clear about eternity:

God has given all authority to Jesus. How we treat Him is going to make all the difference now and in eternity.
