## I. "Whoever" Means Whoever! Revelation 5:9

"Whoever" means the good news about Jesus and eternal life is for everyone.

Whoever means that Jesus is not only the source of God's grace, He is incredibly generous with God's grace!

# II. "Whoever" Means However.

- However means You don't have to <u>fix</u> your life first to be accepted by God.
- However means you don't have to answer all your <u>questions</u> first to be accepted by God.
- However means you don't have to solve all your problems first to be accepted by God. Luke 16: 19–23
