For a fully devoted follower of Jesus there is absolutely no place for a compartmentalization of your faith.

For a fully devoted follower of Jesus there is absolutely no place for a part-time faith.

For a fully devoted follower of Jesus there is an integration of <u>Word</u> and <u>Deeds</u>.

If you have godly word and no deeds your life will lack <u>integrity</u>. But if you have godly deeds and no words your life will lack <u>clarity</u>.
