Jesus taught a lot about finances.

Jesus knew that the chief competitor for our heart and soul’s devotion would be money.

If you choose to live outside where God has chosen to bless...you’re choosing not to position yourself to be blessed.

Fence #1 – Live Inside Your Budget!

There are three different kinds of people who have three different kinds of budgets. *Psalm 24:1 NIV*

God has a heart of compassion for the poor, the displaced, and the marginalized.

God is saying to the affluent, the poor, and the middle class...to live on YOUR budget, you must learn to say enough.

Practically, the easiest way to live on your budget is to adopt the 10/10/80 Plan.

This plan is also called the Give, Save, Live Plan:

- Every time you get a check, profit, windfall, bonus, inheritance, distribution...any income...you give the first 10% to your church. This is called tithing.
- The second 10% is money you save or invest for the future.
- Then the last 80% is what you live on.

Every economic atheist reverses the 10/10/80 plan.

Fence #2 – Honor the Economic Cycle!

God wants to teach His people the value of financial discipline, self-denial and delayed gratification.

The goal of God’s plan is to increase your harvest!
