HOW TO DO WHAT YOU JUST CAN'T DO

"Life-Changing Prayer", 2 Kings 19 March 12 & 15, 2017: Cam Huxford, Senior Pastor

James 1:2-4

We can train to do something that no amount of trying will enable us to do right now.

You may have *tried* prayer...but you have not been *trained* to pray! Which is why we call prayer a spiritual <u>discipline</u>! 2 Kings 18:13 NIV84

- I. Life-Changing Prayer Usually Happens in a Particular Place! Matthew 6:6 NIV
- II. Life-Changing Prayer Usually Follows a Particular Pattern.

Hezekiah is not complimenting God by saying all these nice things about him...Hezekiah begins his prayers in a way that <u>reminds</u> HIMSELF who he is addressing!

There is a huge difference between a wish and a faith filled prayer! Mark 11:24 NIV

The four answers to every prayer: Yes, No, Wait, Grow

The ACTS Acrostic is a great prayer pattern:

- A Adoration...Where we fill our faith tank by acknowledging God's greatness in our life!
- C Confession...I confess the sins I'm conscious of that can hurt my relationship with God.
- T Thanksgiving...I express my gratitude to God for how he has blessed me already!
- S <u>Supplication</u>...I make requests for myself and others so that God's power will present itself in my world.

III. Life-Changing Prayer Usually Has a Particular Purpose: Philippians 4:6-7 NIV

- The Power of Simple Prayers.
- The <u>Sovereignty</u> of Simple Prayers.
- The <u>Point</u> of Simple Prayers. *James 4:3 NIV*

IV. Life-Changing Prayer Usually Results in a Particular Kind of Power and Peace.

Imagine what we would be able to do if we started giving the Lord the first 5" of the day in a simple "so that" prayer!
