I. The Cross Changes Everything, Because it Is the Ultimate Expression of Love.

Matthew 27:11-56; Mark 15:1-41; Luke 22:63 - 23:49; John 18:28-19:30; Colossians 1:20 NIV

Jesus endured the punishment of the cross, so that we could be <u>reconciled</u> to God.

Jesus willingly <u>volunteered</u> to go to the cross to be the perfect sacrifice that would pay for the sins of the world. *Romans 5:6-8 NIV*

Jesus loves <u>undeserving</u> people!

II. The Cross Changes Everything, Because it Is the World's Greatest Sacrifice.

Murder is where someone breaks the law and <u>steals</u> your life from you. A sacrificial death is a willing gift of love. *John 10:17-18 NIV; 2 Corinthians 8 9 NIV*

Jesus embraced the poverty that sin brings on us, so that we could experience the blessing that grace brings through Him.

Isaiah 53:4-6 NIV84; 2 Corinthians 5:21 NIV

III. The Cross Changes Everything, Because it Is the Final Solution for Sin. 1 Peter 3:18 NIV84

Most people think they are morally <u>above average</u>, because they compare themselves to the worst people they know. *Romans 3:23; Hebrews 10:10 NIV*

Jesus designed baptism to be a powerful testimony to what happens at the cross:

- Baptism is a visual illustration of the spiritual <u>cleansing</u> that takes place when you give your life to Jesus. Acts 22:16 NIV
- Baptism is also a drama in which you get to play the part of <u>Jesus</u> in a re-enactment of the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus.

John 3:16-17 NIV; 1 John 4:9-10 NIV

You can leave your sin at the cross and walk away <u>free</u>, because of the heroic death of Jesus on the cross.
